

HANG ON: A SECOND WIND


"Suicide, a thin line between life and death. One who sees it, doesn't cross it. One who doesn't see it, crosses it."

When Premchand was writing the classics of Indian writing, his primary focus was to depict the social conditions prevalent in those times and bring the atrocities faced by the people to light. They became classics because of the subjects that they explored more than anything else. "Hang On a Second Wind" by Eshwarmurthy G Pillai is one of the pioneering books that explore the burning issues of contemporary India and how the common man, who is less common and more of a hero in some sense, faces the situations.

These situations form the heart of the matter in the present-day Indian media and top story highlights.

Pillai's "Hang On a Second Wind" talks about the central issue of farmers and their conditions, which reach the headlines when farmers end their lives but otherwise not even close to it. From another perspective, Subodh's life is also symbolic of the fates of many farmers, but not all (probably none) are lucky to find a Vahni to give them their moments of epiphany and inspire them to set on an altogether different path filled with grit and determination. Subodh breaks the ground with his newfound self and wins the reader's hearts with his resilience and hope to achieve what he has dreamt of all along.

At the same time, "Hang On a Second Wind" may become a study of motivation and optimism for many readers and the ones who are interested in reading the genre. But on closer reading, examining the facts which had led to Subodh's ultimate decision while lying to his family are more significant and worth noting. They show the dark side of the Indian mainland, which is hardly mentioned in any kind of media these days. Pillai does monumental work with his "Hang On a Second Wind" and makes the difference by striking the chord and making the readers ponder.

Pillai follows a different plot concept where he brings the probable end in the beginning and takes the plot in a different direction. This makes his book unpredictable, and the short chapters ensure that the readers enjoy every bit of the story while they think along. Through this work, they also go on a journey into the depths of the Indian system and how things work in the remotest corners of the country, which are yet to experience the effects of the digital revolution.

As the central character, Subodh comes across as the representative of his farmer class and mirrors the problems the farmers of any corner of the world would be facing. He incarnates the worries, stress, and tensions that pervade as routine in their lives. His changed situation from the earlier generations to his present condition speaks volumes of the changed state of farmers from being prosperous to paupers. This is eye-opening and disturbing for both the readers and society. Pankaj Lochan, in his collection of short stories, "Sigma: as life sums it all.." brings many instances and stories that revolve around one thought, which is to show Karma works in a world that is far away from thinking about it. He may have kept as many as 7 stories in his collection, but each story successfully reinforces the message that the author has his focus on. The stories vary in terms of length and also the times they depict. Some show time leaps, while some show the distance leaps. But the fact that can not be ignored is that the author faithfully depicts the ways of the world and their getting the best of their actions.

This element of realism makes Lochan's work even more potent. At the same time, the thorough and honest depiction of human nature also makes "Sigma" universal and realistic. Human nature can never change, and hence, the relevance of his work can not be reduced in any year or time it is read. In light of this, the author successfully shows the cause and effect relationship that pertains to human lives and how lives revolve around it.

Lochan keeps his characters from routine everyday life and places them in situations that humans would generally face at any point in time. This makes the stories more relatable for the readers, and from time to time, they nod or disagree with the moves and actions of the characters. As they finish each story, there is a kind of conclusion or moral given at the end which sums up all that they have read, and even if they may not have understood the story, they are able to comprehend with the help of the conclusion. The stories successfully retain the readers' trust in karma and how life is an equalizer for all. No matter what one does, they get the best of their actions, and the readers agree with that without any disagreement.



At the same time, the situations and plots that the author constructs are placed majorly in the heart of towns away from metropolitans. The action may swing between metropolitan and other cities, but the core of the action is away from the metros. This increases the social relevance of the book and opens it to be read from a sociological point of view. Since the work is realistic and so close to life, "Sigma" appears to be a product of the impressions of a contemporary world where reality is the real deal.

The author chooses the medium of short stories to share the different lives and situations he may have witnessed or heard of. This opens the book to all kinds of readers. All stories keep the readers engaged and by the time they reach the end of each story, there is a sense of satisfaction and also a learning of what may have been ignored by them. 
